## TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

Generally if your child feels unwell, keep them home from school and consult your doctor. This chart and the information it contains is not intended to take the place of a consultation with your doctor.

CONDITION	TIME FROM EXPOSURE TO ILLNESS	EXCLUSION OF CASES
<b>Chickenpox</b>	1-2 weeks	Exclude until all blisters have dried. This is usually at least 5 days after the rash appears in unimmunised children, but may be less in previously immunised children
<b>Conjunctivitis</b>	1-3 days	Exclude until discharge from eyes has ceased.
<b>Diarrhoea and/or Vomiting</b>	Depends on the cause	Exclude until there has not been a loose bowel motion or any vomiting for at least 24 hours (therefore if your child has been sent home do not return them the following day unless they have a doctor's certificate).
<b>Fever</b>	A temperature of 38 degrees or more	Exclude until their temperature returns to normal.
<b>Glandular Fever</b>	4-6 weeks	Exclude until well.
<b>Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease</b>	3-5 days	Exclude until all blisters have dried.
<b>Head Lice</b>	Time from infestation to eggs hatching usually 7-10 days	No as long as lice management is ongoing.
<b>Hepatitis A</b>	2-7 weeks	Exclude until a medical certificate of recovery is received, but not before 7 days after the onset of jaundice or illness.
<b>Impetigo (School Sores)</b>	1-3 days	Exclude until appropriate treatment has commenced. Sore on exposed surfaces must be covered with a watertight dressing.
<b>Influenza/ Influenza like Illnesses</b>	1-3 days	Exclude until well (sneezing and coughing ceases).
<b>Measles (including Rubella)</b>	2-3 weeks	Exclude for at least 4 days after onset of rash.
<b>Mumps</b>	14-25 days	Exclude for 9 days or until swelling goes down (whichever is sooner).
<b>Ringworm</b>	Varies	Exclude until the day after appropriate treatment has commenced.
<b>Scabies</b>	1 day – 6 weeks	Exclude until the day after appropriate treatment has commenced.
<b>Scarlett Fever</b>	1-3 days	Exclude at least 24hrs of treatment has begun and the child is feeling better.
<b>Whooping Cough (Pertussis)</b>	7-20 days	Exclude until they have completed a 5 day course of antibiotic treatment.

Parents need to keep the school informed of any changes to phone numbers, emergency contact information and of any new medical conditions or changes to a child's medical condition.
