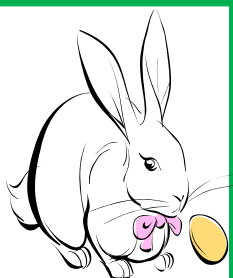

Dear Parents and Carers,

The many programs we offer at Hobartville PS come at a cost. We have tried to minimise the cost over the years and provide excellent opportunities for the students. Last year was very successful with our semester 1 events offering students amazing programs across all areas of the school curriculum.

We have done this again this semester where all excursions and programs have been subsidised for you. There will be a small cost for the overall value of what the programs entail.

In Semester 1 there will be the following events:

- **Mathletics (\$15.00) ,**
- **Aboriginal Education and Science based excursion to Long Neck Lagoon Field Studies Centre (\$25.00),**
- **Sport in Schools Athletics and Gymnastics Program (\$40.00) as well as a Sports in Schools K-6 Athletics Carnival,**
- **Life Skills Program (K-5) and Interrelate Year 6 (\$30)**
- **Sticks and Stones Show (\$5) incorporating our school values, and**
- **NAIDOC Celebrations featuring the Koomurri Troupe (\$10)**

The total cost over the 2 terms would be **\$125.00** if paying individually for each event. If you have a Mathletics subscription at home, this alone would cost \$99.00.

The school and the P&C are subsidising and we are offering all this at a **BARGAIN cost of \$50.00 per student** which is due by the end of the Term 1. This is a substantial saving. You are able to pay now or pay the discounted offer over the term. If you do not pay the \$50.00, your child may still go to the events but will have to pay for each event separately which will add an extra \$75.00 to your costing.

Please return the slip below with your payment or part payment. Extra payment slips will be available in the front office.

Please come and see me if you have any concerns in regards to this opportunity or making payments.

The \$3.00 for the swimming carnival is not included as all students do not attend. All these events listed above will be occurring in the first half of the year. Stage 3 Camp is also not included.

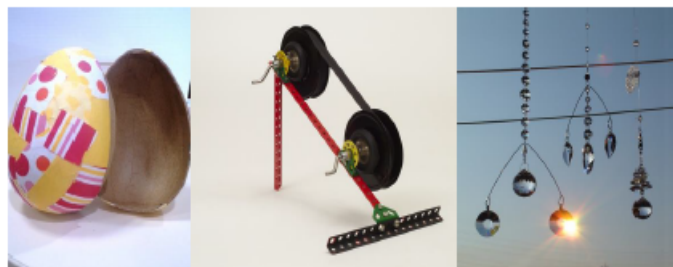
