NAPLAN Online

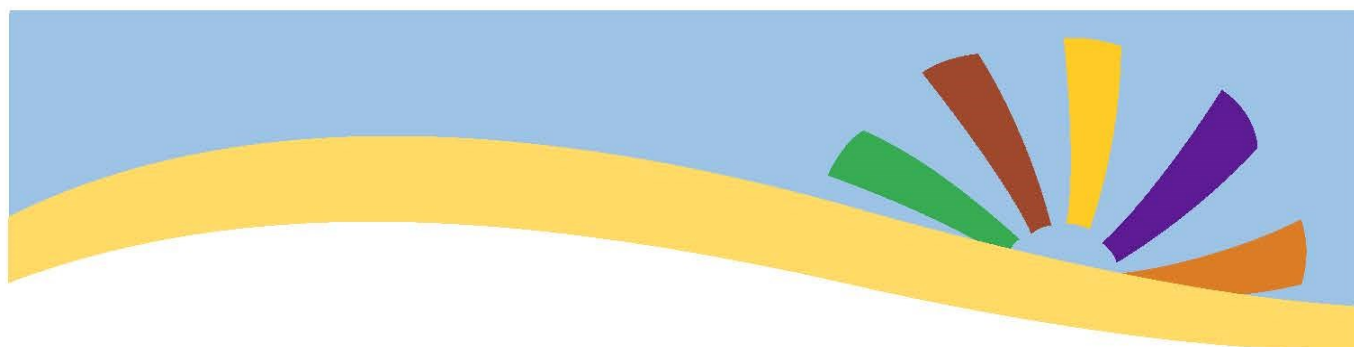
