What to bring

- Pillow, sleeping bag or doona and two single flat sheets (Sydney Academy provide pillows)
- Day backpack
- Paper, pens or pencils
- Plastic bags for dirty or wet clothes
- Medication (if required)
- Tissues
- Water bottle

Optional

- Camera (this can be a mobile phone, HOWEVER please remove the sim card prior to camp to ensure the phone is just used for its camera ONLY.
- Up to \$30 for souvenirs

NO electronic devices or extra foods, such as lollies are to be brought to camp.

Please remember that the final payments need to be paid ASAP.
